INTERPOL Washington responds to your letter of August 27, 2015 concerning the case of Russian citizen Pavel Zabelin, and in particular, the INTERPOL red notice based on Russian charges relating to Mr. Zabelin. The red notice on Mr. Zabelin was designated for public dissemination by Russian authorities at the time it was requested. We are pleased to report that the red notice has been cancelled and is no longer active in INTERPOL's system, nor visible on INTERPOL's public website which contains active red notices.
